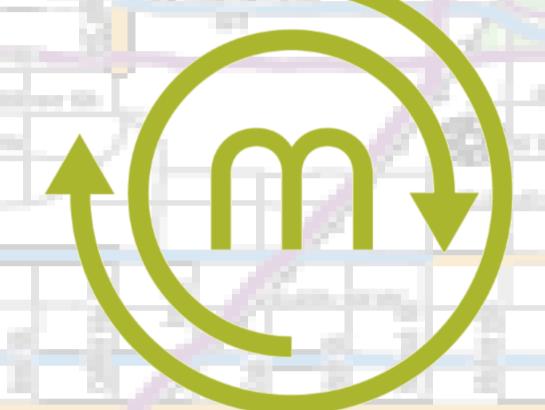

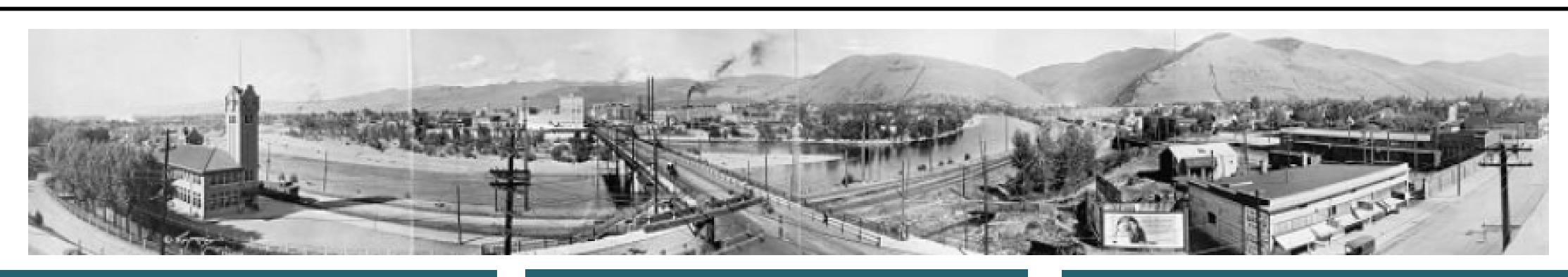
# Mision
