# LEADERBOARDS EXPLAINED

#### **HOW LEADERBOARDS WORK:**

- The Way to Go! Missoula Leaderboards are based on the percentage of "active" participants out of the total number of employees at your workplace. A user only needs to log one trip by carpool, bike, walk, telecommute, compressed workweek, vanpool, or bus to be counted as "active".
- The Leaderboards track the percentage of DAYS (not trips) that your team members logged sustainable trips out of the total number of days that they COULD HAVE logged sustainable trips which is 10. The number of team members used to calculate percentages is the total number of ALL employees at your workplace - so even the ones who do not have Way to Go accounts are being factored into calculations.
  - For example: an organization has 10 total employees, there are 5 legible days in the week and 4 of them log each day. The network would then have (4x5)/(10/5) = 40% participation for the week.

#### WHEN LEADERBOARDS MATTER:

- Remember, if there is only 1 Team in a size category that achieves All-Star status (a.k.a. gets every single person at the workplace to log a trip) then that team WINS their size category and the Leaderboards do not matter. But they are fun to look at and show some pretty impressive stats!
- If a size category has more than I team to achieve All-Star status, or if none of the teams in the size category achieve All-Star status, then the size category winner is determined by the Leaderboard.

### NUMBER OF TRIPS LISTED:

- The Leaderboards display a number of trips associated with each person on the team. If you select a team from the list, you will see further stats calculating the impact of the total number of trips logged by the entire team.
- The numbers listed here include ALL of the TRIPS (not days) logged by the members of that team, including errands which do not count towards the challenge. These numbers ARE NOT used to calculate Leaderboard standings.
